

## Studi Verdiani online at Torrossa.it

To mark the 200th anniversary of the birth of Giuseppe Verdi, Casalini Libri and the Istituto Nazionale di Studi Verdiani are pleased to announce the online publication of the "Studi Verdiani" digital collection.



The digitization of the Institute's print volumes provides a rich resource for **scholars** and **specialist music libraries** thoughout the world, making newly available many titles of value and interest.

The collection comprises **22** issues of the official journal of the institution and 38 volumes of monographs and conference proceedings, and includes titles of particular importance: the volumes of the Epistolario verdiano, such as the Carteggi Verdi-Ricordi, Verdi-Boito and Verdi-Cammarano; monographic volumes on Verdi's works (Aida, Un ballo in maschera and Rigoletto, among others); as well as studies on the creation and staging of Verdi's works.
