Professional library customers are granted free access, via individual registration, to our complete bibliographical database, www.ilibri.com. The database is updated on a daily basis to ensure an up-to-date resource for sourcing both print and electronic publications.

Our online bibliographic records offer a variety of additional information and collection development tools: Tables of Contents, covers, abstracts, sample pages and lists of core titles. This information is completely searchable by using the advanced search filters, including geographic and temporal subdivisions, keyword within abstract and ToC, and format. Search criteria may be saved and bibliographic profiles created for use in future searches, while personalised New Title Information profiles are visible online and may be used to refine web searches.

Electronic titles are featured alongside print publications and show the list price for institutional purchase. Title records show clearly the book format and provide a link to the alternative version, where available.

Online order management tools allow users to compile lists of selections and order directly through the website. Exactly the same procedures are applied to both print and electronic editions, simplifying the selection and acquisition of single e-books. Internal library data may be added to orders and reproduced in MARC records, if required. An Account Master function is also available.

Notes showing titles already on order for the library help to avoid duplicates and let you view order status and delivery information. Digital publications already included in your institution's collection of e-content in Torrossa are identifiable by a special icon. An online invoice archive permits the consultation and download of PDF invoice copies.
